Specification	Most tasks are carried out on an as and when basis rather than being confined to a rigid schedule but, grass cutting will be on average twice per month, hedge and shrub pruning twice per year, litter picking and cleansing based activities will take place most days.
Staff and Equipment	The town centre operational team will have access to a 3.5 ton vehicle, small mechanical sweeper and all other small tools and equipment as and when needed. Tree maintenance is carried out either via the Councils inhouse team or by contractors. Any larger scale works or special projects requiring additional resources will be enabled by using operatives from other Environmental Services teams.  The town centre operational team consists of 3 members of staff who work from 6.00am until 2.15pm Monday to Thursday and 6.00am to 1.45pm on Fridays.

	The Environmental Services weekend team cover the hours between 6.00am and 2.15pm on a Saturday and Sunday. During those times the town centre will receive basic cleansing maintenance including litter picking and the emptying of bins.
Performance Measures	Performance is monitored via our electronic customer management system and the relevant data/demand is presented to the Environmental Services Management Team on a monthly basis. The system is also used daily by the operational teams to organise and prioritise their workloads and, the team's performance is monitored on site by the team Co-ordinator.
